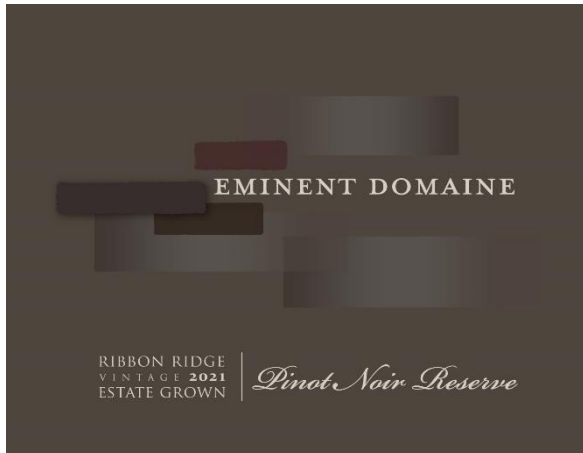

## 2021 Reserve Pinot Noir

Price: \$75 retail / \$60 club price

Vineyard: Eminent Domaine Estate

AVA: Ribbon Ridge

Production: 208 cases produced

Alcohol: 14.1%

Oak: 50% New French Oak

Soil: Marine Sedimentary

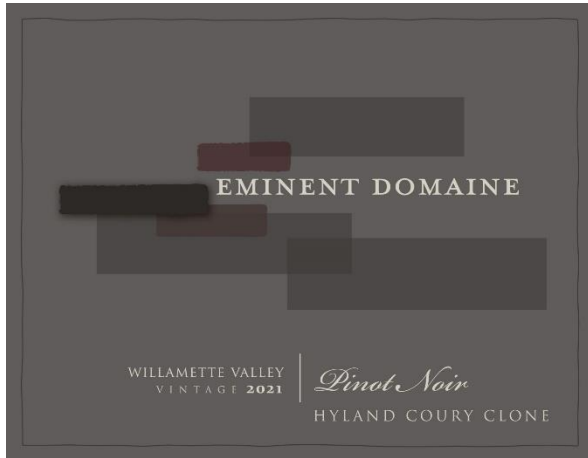
Clones: Pommard & Dijon 115

*Some barrels simply stand out, reminding you of everything you love about pinot noir. It's like the precious nectar we've worked tirelessly for all year (and every year)! The terroir, weather, sustainable farming, winemaking, pinnacle decisions and painstaking effort we make to represent the forever changing nuances that make every vintage unique. The Reserve is something we're proud to label as our own, as Eminent Domaine Wine at its best. And we hope you'll agree, expresses everything a fine Oregon pinot noir can be.*

*Specifically, the Pommard grows in the eastern planting of the Estate Vineyard and forms the bulk of the Reserve. We then add a small amount of fruit from the center of our Estate Vineyard, the Dijon 115 clone. This lighter, structured clone adds a special complexity to the Pommard that truly expresses the beautiful uniqueness only found in the Ribbon Ridge AVA.*

*The rounded plum and red fruit notes bring structure with a soft finish, while the Dijon 115 adds a splash of spice and intensity. Dark and luscious, this will cellar beautifully and is always a perfect choice for celebrating any special occasion. Drink 2024 through 2030.*

### **2021 Hyland Coury Clone Pinot Noir**

Vineyard: Hyland Estate

AVA: McMinnville AVA

Production: 120 cases produced

Alcohol: 13.5%

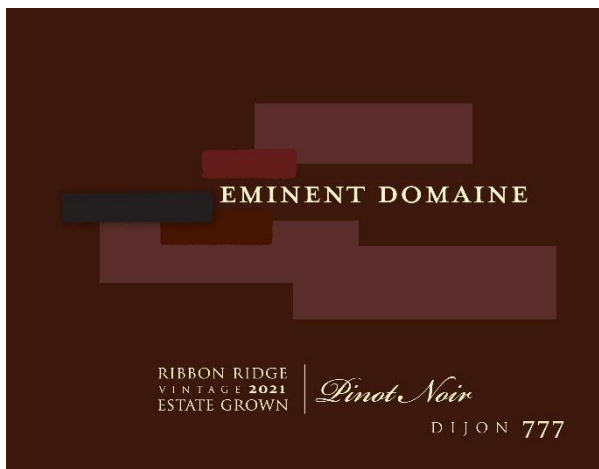
Oak: 35% New French Oak

Soil: Volcanic / Jory Soils

Clones: Coury Clone, 1973 planting

*The Hyland Coury Clone has been a favorite of ours for years with its distinctive herbal nose that evolves into floral aromatics. The uniqueness of the Coury Clone is undeniable and represents the birth of Oregon pinot noir, being from one of the oldest blocks of vines in the Willamette Valley. Planted 50 years ago by one of our wine industry's founders, Dr. Charles Coury, this fruit is rare and special on the vine and in bottle.*

*With a little time in the glass, the red berries and savory undertones lead to woody notes, followed by a savory herbal finish. It is this dynamic, evolving wine that defines what we love and respect about the history and beauty of "old world" pinot noir. Typically, it needs time to mature, but the mild summer in 2021 gives this vintage a structure that is approachable now. It will only get better with age, but it may be difficult to wait for this one to cellar. Drink 2024 through 2030.*



### **2021 Estate Dijon 777 Pinot Noir**

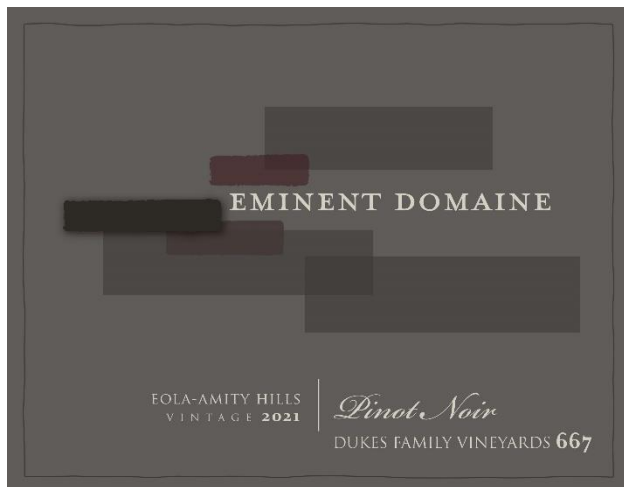
Alcohol: 14.1%

Oak: 35% New French Oak

Soil: Marine Sedimentary

Clones: Dijon 777

*Bright, lively and expressive; the Estate Dijon 777 is bottled by itself because of its distinctive and charming qualities. Look for fresh strawberry and raspberry notes. While featuring a single clone, it is a great way to examine the purity of the fruit. This pretty and juicy red fruited pinot noir is an annual favorite and always the first wine to sell out each vintage. Drink 2023 to 2026.*

bottling of Dijon 667 Pinot Noir**

Alcohol: 13.7%

Oak: 30% New French Oak

Soil: Volcanic (Nekia) Soil

Clones: Dijon 667

*In this 2021 pinot noir we were able to try something a little different, a single clone bottling of Dijon 667 from the Dukes Family Vineyard. Located in the Eola Amity AVA, this vineyard is an impressive site with Volcanic Nekia soil and steep, high plantings. We sourced from our two favorite blocks that showcase the distinctive tannic, structural and brambly characteristics of the area. Partial whole-cluster fermentation further highlights the purity of*

*Having a richer, darker expression, this clone is a favorite especially with its bright raspberry notes and complexity. We considered blending it with the Dijon 777 from the same vineyard but felt that it really stood out as exceptional by itself. This was a favorite for our staff during blending and is sure to be a crowd pleaser. Drink 2023 through 2026.*
